- Title: The 46th National Museum of Korea Painting Festival 2021
- Participant: Any student enrolled in elementary, middle, and high school or children and youth in the same age group(including foreigner)
- How to Participate: Appreciate the National Museum of Korea's collection and complete a painting. Submit the artwork via postal mail.

- Application Period: May 14 (Fri) - May 24 (Mon) 2021, 18:00 pm
- Awards: Total 60 awardees, including Grand Prize (Culture, Sports and Tourism Minister's Award): 4 persons, Creative Award (National Museum of Korea Director General's Award): 56 persons.
- Prize Winner Announcement: June 7 (Mon) 2021, 10:00 am
- Award Ceremony: Early July
- Prize Winner Exhibition: July 10 (Sat) - August 22 (Sun) 2021. At the lobby on the way to the Children's Museum at the National Museum of Korea

- How to Apply: ① Original painting, ② Application form & Legal representative consent form (For children under 14 years of age), ③ Description of painting, ④ Consent for collection and use of personal information and copyright and related rights. [Send them via postal mail.](#)
  - [Your application is effective only when the postal package is delivered to the National Museum of Korea by 18:00 pm on May 24 \(Mon\), 2021.](#) When your application is registered, you will get a text message.
  - [Description of Painting must be handwritten by the applicant himself or herself.](#)

- Please mark the title of the painting and the applicant's information (Name, school, school year, and contact number) on the back of the original painting.
- You can download the application form, the legal representative consent form (For children under 14 years of age), the description of painting, and the consent for collection and use of personal information and copyright and related rights at the National Museum of Korea's website.
- Painting Size: Drawing paper (272x394mm) - Elementary school students or children in the same age group  
Drawing paper (394x545mm) - Middle and high school students or youth in the same age group
- No restriction on coloring materials.

## ☐ **Notice**

- Incorrect size of the painting or any omission of required documents, including the application form, the legal representative consent form (for children under 14 years of age), the description of painting, and the consent for collection and use of personal information and copyright and related rights, will be excluded from evaluation.
- The Description of Painting must be handwritten by the applicant himself or herself.
- Please note that onsite application is not available.
- We don't accept any group application, including school or private institute. Please submit your application individually.
- The number of awardees may change depending on the number of entries and evaluation results.

- The winning artworks may be open and utilized for the Museum's programs, including exhibition, publication, education, and promotion.
- Every benefit of the festival participation, award, and prize will be retracted, award and prize will be returned to the National Museum of Korea if the selected artwork is later found to be "not the original creation of the applicant," which means a preexisting work, a work that stole or plagiarized someone's work, and a work that received help from someone.
- Submitted work will not be returned individually. After the prize winner exhibition is over, you may visit the museum to retrieve your work until December 31 (Fri), 2021. After the date, it will be discarded.
- The museum is not responsible for any damage to the painting caused during delivery.
- Each applicant is responsible for any issue caused by the misunderstanding of the application guidelines and details.
